- Mission Innovation will produce a suite of communication products for COP28, including an MI Agenda detailing relevant side-events for stakeholders, a Hero Video featuring MI stakeholders discussing the role of innovation in accelerating the energy transition, and a Comms Toolkit for sharing key messages, hashtags, and suggested social media posts. We will also make a series of social media posts leading up to, during, and after COP28.
